Key Grammar Concepts

- Possessive adjectives (mi, tu, su, etc.).
- Basic sentence structure: Subject + verb + object.
- Simple questions (¿Qué?, ¿Cómo?, ¿Dónde?, ¿Cuándo?).
- Basic negation: No, nunca.
- Personal pronouns (yo, tú, él, ella, etc.).
